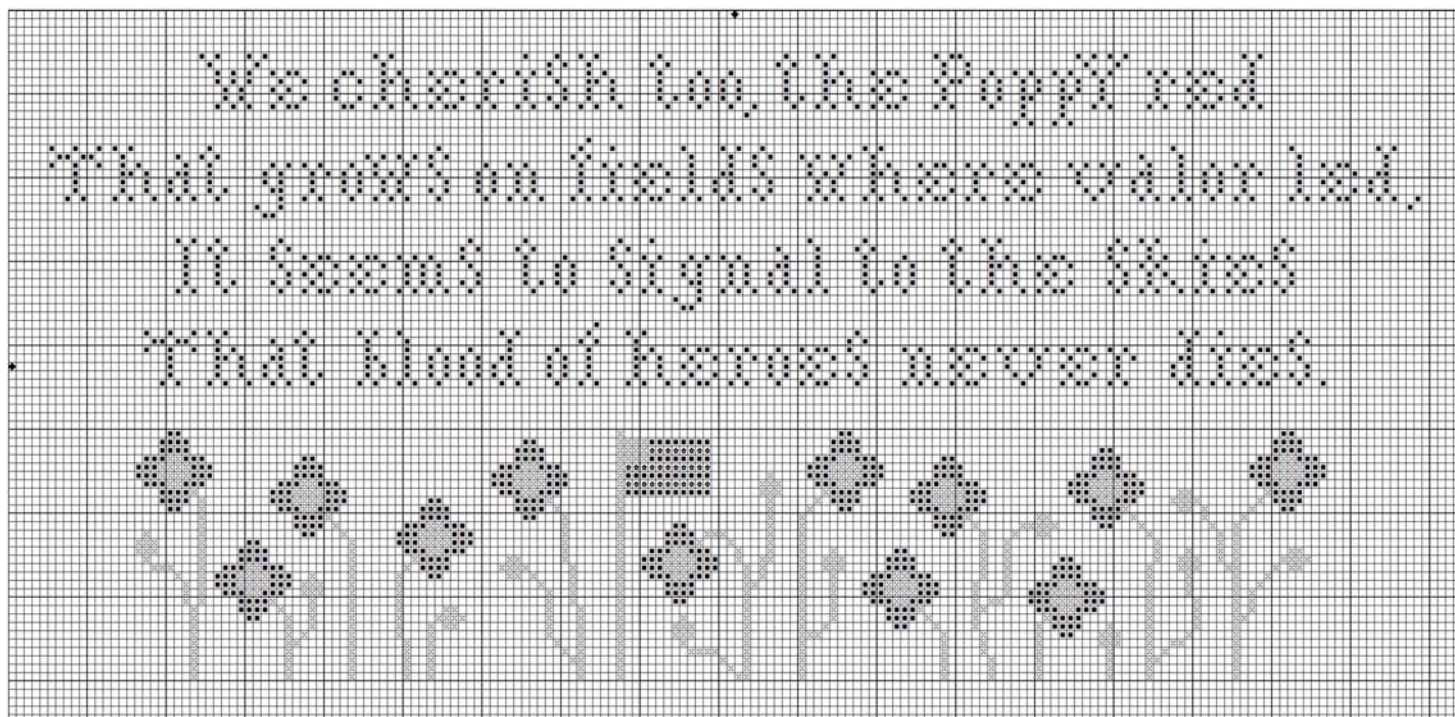


A Patriot's Sampler
